**Purpose:** Facilitators or teams may select this protocol if they want to share information on a large amount of text by having each member read and share a portion of the text with the group.

20 min	<ul> <li>5. Each group member shares their two statements from step 4 with the group.</li> <li>6. The other 3 group members each have the opportunity to ask one clarifying question.</li> <li>7. Repeat steps 5 &amp; 6 for each member of the group.</li> </ul>	Timekeeper: Check that each person has 5 minutes to share, including responses to clarifying questions.  Facilitator: Ensure that each person asks the speaker no more than <b>one</b> clarifying question.
10 min	8. Participants look through <i>The Adaptive School</i> at one of the four text sections they would like to review.
